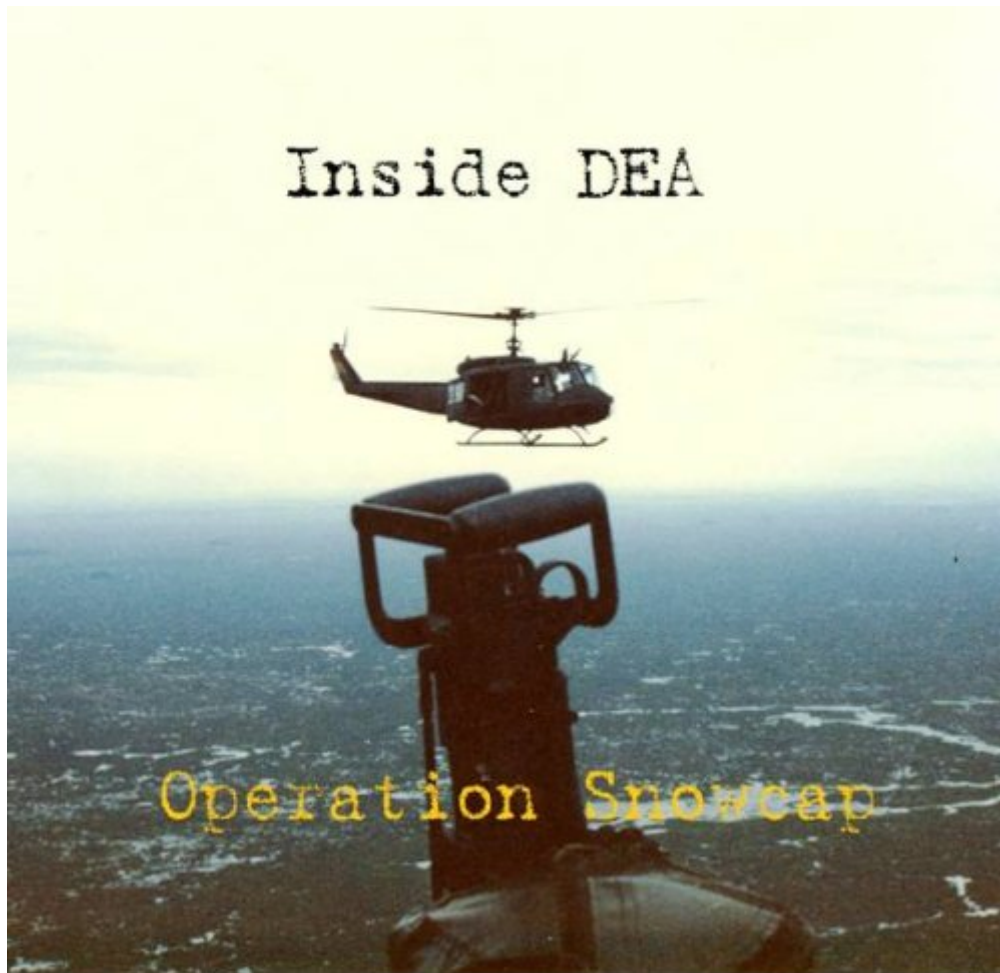

About once a chapter the author wades into his own (sometimes irrelevant) political viewpoints, which makes it a bit like talking to your cool grandpa about his career in the drug war. Awesome stories and good insight into an historic campaign in South America, peppered with curmudgeonly grumbling about tree-hugging commies.

This is an excellent 'insider' view of the "Drug War" through the years. Mr. Hartman has 'been there and done that' many times over. To his credit, he is still 'involved'. He, like many other unsung heroes did what he could do to try and 'stem the flow' of illegal narcotics.
