

I have been a loyal follower of Drew Lindsayâ ™s Ben Hood series since his first book - Coral Sea Affair and now have all 17; including the most recent - South Pacific Affair. This is the best one yet. This time Ben has two gorgeous women to protect against several nasty folks who are after a necklace stolen from the King of Tonga and which has been augmented by a priceless white diamond. Neither of the women have any idea of its location and the search is on and the bodies pile up and Ben, as usual, does things his own way to the dismay of the local law, in Australia and Tonga. To no oneâ ™s surprise, he does get very close to a beautiful lady but youâ ™ll have to read South Pacific Affair to find out who. Good plot, great pace and a fun read, as always. Editing has improved immensely over the last several books with Drew's wife taking on those chores

(thanks Narelle). You can read this book as a stand-alone as there are fewer direct references to past 'cases' and a shortened version of the relationships between Rodney, Rose and Ben but you'll wind up wanting to get the first one and working your way through them all in order to see how Drew has developed Ben over time. The best news is that yet another Ben Hood is coming shortly and we hope Drew doesnâ ™t run out of ideas for a long time.

Ben Hood rocks. This one starts with a body. The body is found in a creek just outside Sydney. The victim has been tortured. Its later found via autopsey that he's died from the use of sodium pentahol. From there the story goes to the island nation of Tonga and another island named Fa Fa. The king of this nation was negotiating with the victim about the return of a stolen necklace. The necklace is quite valuable and made more so by the addition of a white diamond. A diamond that was part of the crown jewels that Cromwell sold in the 1600's. The king wants the Tongan necklace back and he also wants to return the diamond to the Queen of England. Problem is no one knows where the victim, Hunter, hid the necklace. In Sydney the victims wife Sophia and her personal assistant Anne will need a bodyguard. Enter Ben Hood. A Ben who's tired and really doesn't want the assignment as he's just returned from Lord Howe's island. Rod talks him into going to see the wife. Once there Ben meets Sophia Hunter and her PA Anne. Sophia is one beautiful woman. A woman who knew absolutely nothing about what her husband was doing. The necklace? She has no idea where it is. Of course there will be folks who won't believe her so a bodyguard she does need. Ben Hood will be that bodyguard. So begins another great Ben Hood adventure. This one has Ben, Sophia Hunter, her PA Anne, a woman named Claudia, another beauty named Loa Tei, her parents, threats, Isaac Ford, the necklace everyone is trying to recover, betrayal, a black pool, a few heavies who end up in the hospital or dead, the police, the Tongan military and Ben Hood once again saving the day. Another great read by Lindsay. Five Stars and then some.
