

I have read this author for some time now, gritting my teeth at times, but overall unable to resist her next story. This time she has outdone herself. This story shows real progress as a writer with well-defined story-line, characters, and much fewer missing words than has been her habit. Just so wonderful to see and I really enjoyed this! Two thumbs up and I recommend as a light read with an adorable hero and heroine and a pretty HEA as well as gentle lead-in for the next book. Again, congratulations, EA Price.

I loved Gunnar and Erin. The plot was fast-paced and interesting. I love how the author has interjected humor along with the passion and love the characters feel. E A Price has written so many books that I have so thoroughly enjoyed that she is on my "automatically buy" list! I highly recommend buying this book (or any of her books!)

Wow! This is the first book I've read by Price and it will not be the last!!!!! This is an amazing start to a series! I can not believe I stumbled upon this book I had never herd of Price before. I am hoping that will be adding this to suggested books! (Just to be sure I will find a news feed from the author just to be sure I'm up to date!) Read this it has everything as for the wolf I can not wait to read that one! No cliff hanger just set up for continuation of the series!

This book has nothing original, nor it is well written. But the biggest problem is the female lead - I can't call her the heroine. It's as if the author wanted to invent someone who is stupider, needier, less mature, more careless and of average appearance, so that an insecure female reader could think, "Well even I wouldn't be THAT bad, but she still got the over-the-top hero! There's hope for me yet!" The female lead has only two things going for her: she is psychic and the shifter hero instantly *knows* he must have her. Better living through chemistry, I guess. She is supposed to be an elite agent but is always doing Too Stupid To Live things that require rescue. Her personality is repellent too: needy, jealous, unable to form a real friendship (as opposed to just "going to lunch and shopping"), immature, no interest in truly learning or being better. At times I actually wondered if the author were a man writing under a female pseudonym, because the female characters have every ugly stereotypic flaw and no true independence or strength. Even as a shallow escapist read, I was repeatedly annoyed enough to spoil any enjoyment I might have had. There is far better writing in this genre out there, for example most of Jennifer Ashley's. This book was pretty much a copycat attempt that was skin deep and without appealing characters or a convincing emotional

connection. The only positive thing I can say is that at least in this book women are not raped and brutalized by dominating "heroes," something that is disturbingly common in women's fiction. In my opinion, this book is harmless, just boring and annoying.

Just the type of story I enjoy. Handsome Alpha Bear meets his smart human mate, where he wasn't too over the top and she wasn't a wimp. Nice romance, adventure mixed with suspense. The story was laid our nicely with what I felt was an above satisfactory ending. I can't wait until the next book.

Oh how I love Ms Price's SEA series. This one had it all! It was dramatic and action packed, a definite thriller. Oh and it was cute, and funny. There was even some hot shifter sex. If you haven't read any of the books about the SEAyou need to.

Picked this book up for the price, shocked at how much I actually enjoyed the book! I read a freaking ton of paranormal romances, shifters and vampires and everything else under the sun and I tend to be super picky about my selections but I truly did enjoy this book! It wasn't that is was better than anything else I've read but it had a nice pace (the couple didn't just fall in love at first site, lust yes but not love) which made it so much more realistic, if you forget that it's a world full of shifters lol! Erin was funny! I loved how awkward she was and she reminded me of a real person. Gunner was alpha male and gruff which I swoon over I swear. I liked the action a lot and the story line wasn't overly crazy with bad guys just falling from the sky at every turn. Romance was a nice build and the love scenes weren't bad either, nicely done! I will read the second book once it comes out!

I made it to the 19% mark before I gave up. Insta-love with a nice helping of failure to communicate. All of the plot elements that would have been interesting were glossed over to focus on Erin's insecure crushing on Gunner. In the end, what could have been an interesting investigation for the first portion of the story became the backdrop for Erin trying to keep her inexplicable, irrational, overwhelming lust under control. If you want romance, where the rest of the action is secondary, you'll probably like it. If you care about her job, what's going on, etc, my guess is you'll feel pretty "meh" about it.
