

I am the Program Director for a Medical Assisting Program and highly recommend this book to all of my students. It has more questions than any other books I've used but the best part is that every question has a rationale/explanation. Not errors noted. I got a 729 (98%) on the CMA and I had a student that studied only from this book and got a 711 (97%.

The CD-Rom that contains the extra tests does not work. There is a known problem with the software, and there is no patch or support. You cannot use the practice tests, unless you are inclined to look up the answers for each of the 3 tests, at 300 questions per test. When I called Prentice Hall, they basically said they were sorry, and hung up.

The book itself is great. It would be a very useful tool if not for the highlighting throughout the book. In the description for it stated that there was "some" highlighting marks. Throughout the entire book

on every test the correct answer is highlighted, defeating the purpose of the book. Very disappointing.

I was studying for my CMA exam from 3 different sources and this one was the most challenging. I can honestly say that I passed the test (a week ago- yey!) thanks to this awesome book! The questions are the hardest out of many textbooks (my other two sources were actually newer textbooks), it has a CD with bunch of practice tests as well. Go for it!UPDATEp.s. I just found out I passed with 99% score - I have to contribute a lot of that to this book!

I just took the CMA exam and passed using this book to study from. Not knowing where to begin (because the exam covers everything) I started with two study sources, but after reading the reviews for this book i purchased it and found i made the right choice! I found this one to be very clear and it covered everything. I would highly recommend this to anyone taking the CMA exam!

I bought this book with the intentions that the CD that came along with it would work. But the CD has a crack in it and does not work, had I known the CD did not work I would not have bought this product. Very disappointed.
