

Considering the short length of this book I was surprised at it's density. I do think it is a fair introduction to the Natyasastra, but perhaps not best for the complete beginner as there are many sanskrit words which are not always completely explained. I would've liked some pictures and diagrams showing the measurements and types of stages, etc rather than just written explaination. Indeed, the author does state in the introduction that he hopes a "younger" author will carry the torch and create an even more detailed introduction on the subject, but currently this seems to be the only introduction book out there.
